As we concluded our first term, I was delighted to reflect on the exciting journey we embarked upon together. It has been a privilege to commence my tenure as the Principal of Wallaroo Primary School, and I am grateful for the warm welcome and support from students, staff, and families.

New Initiatives: We launched our very own Wallaroo Primary Anchor Podcast. This platform has allowed us to share our learning, achievements, and insights from our school community. It has been wonderful to hear the voices of our students and we look forward to more engaging episodes in the coming terms.

Kindness Walk: Our Junior Primary students participated in a heartwarming initiative called the Kindness Walk. They created beautiful kindness rocks, each with a unique message of positivity and encouragement. These rocks were placed around the Wallaroo community, spreading joy and kindness to all who discovered them. It was a wonderful opportunity for our students to engage with the community and learn the value of kindness. Within this unit of work, our students worked on curriculum learning in Mathematics, English, Social Skills and more. Students created maps of the town, made 3D maps to small scale and learned what being kind looks and feels like. They had put a lot of thought into where they were placing their rocks and what message their rocks would include. We hope you got as much joy finding the rocks as our learners did creating them!

Upper Primary Interviews on Anchor Podcast: Our Upper Primary students had the unique opportunity to interview our Copper Coast Mayor, Roslyn Talbot. This experience not only enhanced their communication skills but also provided them with insights into local governance and community leadership. We are proud of their curiosity and professionalism during this project.

Focus on Learner Agency and Hands-On Math: This term, we are focusing on enhancing learner agency and promoting hands-on learning in Mathematics. In collaboration with the Math Association of South Australia, we have implemented innovative strategies to make Math more engaging and interactive. Our students have enjoyed exploring mathematical concepts through practical activities, fostering a deeper understanding and love for the subject. We are engaging in learning as a staff with Lisa Burman. She has written many books about learner agency. We have already gained a lot of knowledge whilst embarking on Professional Development with her.

Easter Raffle: A highlight of this term was our Easter Raffle, driven by the Wallaroo Primary School community. 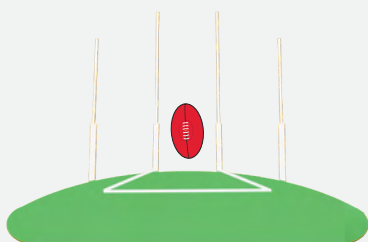
